Contractors and vendors perform high-risk maintenance and utility work in active patient care areas every day. When that work proceeds without verified controls or documented approvals, the risks extend well beyond the job site. A strong permit process helps healthcare organizations address these risks by:

Protecting patients and staff.

High-risk work near active care areas requires verified controls and coordinated sign-off, not assumptions or verbal handoffs.

Streamlining processes.

Permit workflows running on paper, email, or phone calls create bottlenecks, missed approvals, and no shared visibility across Facilities, EHS, and department managers.

Ensuring compliance.

Without audit-ready permit records, organizations face exposure under the Joint Commission, NFPA 241, and OSHA standards for high-hazard work.

Digitize Permit Workflows From Request Through Closeout

Replace paper, email, and verbal handoffs with a structured digital process that enforces the right steps before work begins.

- Standardize digital intake for hot work, confined space, HVAC shutdowns, and other high-risk activity types.
- Verify hazard controls and required prerequisites before a permit is issued to begin work.
- Route approvals to Facilities, EHS, department leads, and Infection Control in one coordinated workflow.
- Track active, expired, and closed permits in real time across all facilities and sites.
- Automate closeout documentation and capture audit-ready records at the completion of each job.
- Give field teams and contractors mobile access to permits and checklists from anywhere on campus.

Manage the Complexity of High-Risk Work in Healthcare

- Connect permit data to incident trends to identify patterns and prevent future safety events.

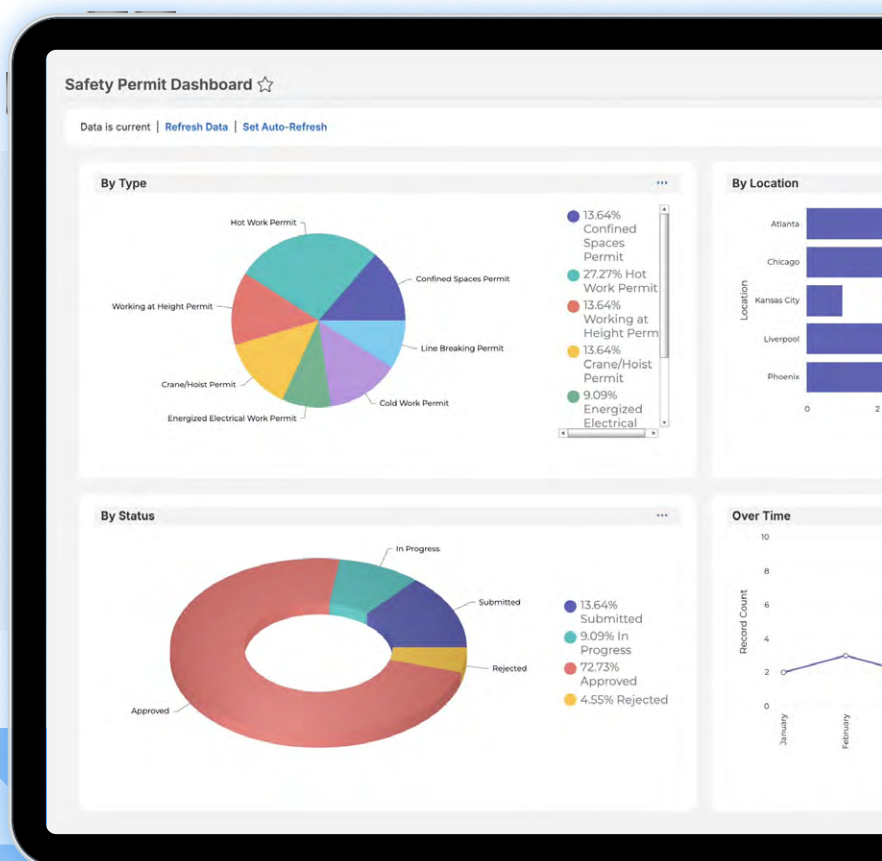
